OUR HOLIDAY DISCOUNT STRUCTURE

We continue to offer Discounts that encourage the purchase of larger Orders to help us offset the Credit Card Processing Fees we must absorb as a vendor. Most Credit Card Fees are 2.9% + \$0.30 per Transaction - on a \$5 purchase, that amounts to about 9%.
