Regrettably, after three Franklin County Commissioner Meetings, a unanimous vote approved the Special Use Permit (SUP) for the construction of a 245-ft Verizon Cell Tower on lands adjacent to our 55-ac Lynch Creek Farm property. My efforts to stop approval failed, but local Franklin Times news coverage was extensive, while the Permit Hearing Process was pathetic.

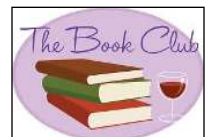
I am also working to find Housing for the Homeless in Franklin County. Winter is rapidly approaching - the most dangerous time for the Homeless each year. Most certainly not a new problem throughout the USA, low cost and subsidized housing is almost non-existent. I believe FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) may hold the key to a solution. Rather than lofty, long-term housing construction solutions, why can't FEMA Trailers be individually located - perhaps on sympathetic Church grounds - to overcome the familiar "NIMBY" property owner objections. Franklin County needs to create a very modest goal, like - "Let's get six homeless individuals off the street this coming winter." Something MUST be done!

FREEZE OUR BREADS

I highly recommend that the best way to preserve our Breads is to slice them immediately after pickup, then package them tightly in zip-lock plastic bags and place them in the freezer.

Take out slices as needed and reheat them in a TOASTER or TOASTER OVEN - NEVER MICROWAVE them!

I guarantee the Breads will taste like they just came fresh out of the oven.

They can be kept frozen, if packaged tightly, for an incredibly long time without sacrificing their taste or texture.

Because we are only baking once a month, you can buy larger quantities, and enjoy the Breads throughout the month.
