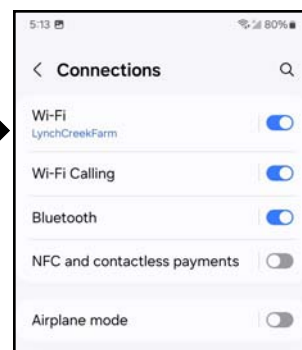

CABIN TECHNOLOGY UPDATE - INTERNET and TELEPHONE ACCESS

If you have attended a recent event, you know that we now provide Starlink-enabled Internet access both indoors and out. Our Cabin grounds provide the secure Wi-Fi Network "LynchCreekFarm" with the password "LCFguest" that is implemented by an Ethernet-enabled, EERO router.

We recommend that you first Sign-on to our Wi-Fi Network with your Smart phone and verify your new Wi-Fi connectivity using any Browser to access the Internet; then Enable the "Wi-Fi Calling" setting on your Smartphone to activate telephone access to your Service Provider with our Network.

Our Guest Network will however restrict your Internet Access to certain activities you normally can perform on your Home/Private Network, like: access to any network files, audio streaming, and control of other smart devices. Let us know if you experience any Telephone or Internet Access difficulties.



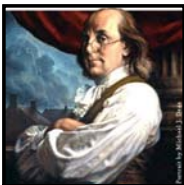
CABIN BACKGROUND MUSIC UPGRADE

FREEZE OUR BREADS

I highly recommend that the best way to preserve our Breads is to slice them immediately after pickup, then package them tightly in zip-lock plastic bags and place them in the freezer.

Take out slices as needed and reheat them in a TOASTER or TOASTER OVEN - NEVER MICROWAVE them!

I guarantee the Breads will taste like they just came fresh out of the oven.

They can be kept frozen, if packaged tightly, for an incredibly long time without sacrificing their taste or texture.

Because we are only baking once a month, you can buy larger quantities, and enjoy the Breads throughout the month.
