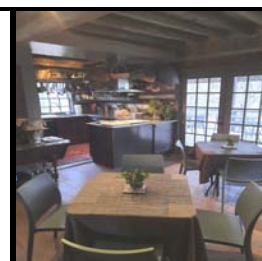

2026 GREENHOUSE RESTORATION :: FARM-TO-TABLE COMING SOON

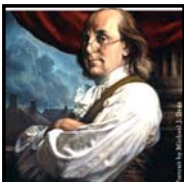
Thanks to the volunteer help of the BFS Board of Directors, Lynch Creek Farm's Greenhouse is being restored to full operation and should begin growing fresh produce for use at Philly in the Woods Dining Events. Bob Radcliffe built the 24'x92' Solar High Tunnel in 2004 and initially provided CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) subscription services.

In 2024, Bob began restoration of the structure in anticipation of covering the frame with agricultural plastic, preparing the soil and beginning to grow produce once again. On Friday, January 9th, Board Members Will Hinton, Terry Crawford, Jim Casazza and Denis Kingberg (Photo L->R) helped Bob "re-top" the frame with plastic. On Thursday, January 22nd, Bob and Will Hinton began "broadforking" the soil. We plan to complete all soil-prep by the end of February. Initial succession planting should begin in March. Philly in the Woods may begin to be advertised as Farm-to-Table later this year! Teamwork makes anything possible. More details later.

FREEZE OUR BREADS

I highly recommend that the best way to preserve our Breads is to slice them immediately after pickup, then package them tightly in zip-lock plastic bags and place them in the freezer.

Take out slices as needed and reheat them in a TOASTER or TOASTER OVEN - NEVER MICROWAVE them!

I guarantee the Breads will taste like they came out of the oven. They can be kept frozen, if packaged tightly, for an incredibly long time without sacrificing their taste or texture.

Because we are only baking once a month, you can buy larger quantities, and enjoy the Breads throughout the month.
